We are curating Un-Speakers to do one of three things: All sessions will be delivered from the comfort of your studio - be that from your professional studio, office or bedroom. But you MUST be able to guarantee that you will be appropriately lit and staged (i.e. following the rule of 3rds with an appropriate background, etc.), with a great camera, sound and internet connection.

In the Professional Development space, Professional Speakers Australia (PSA) is committed to supporting Professional Members (PM) in achieving their business development goals, including CSP. The CSP Pathway commenced in January 2022, with strategic planning for each enrolled PM then mentoring and group coaching. The purpose is to provide more guidance and direction for Professional Members to develop both their speaking skills and speaking practice. Around 40% of Australian members are CSPs. PSA is also embarking on a "next-gen" project to identify and develop relationships with remarkable and outstanding speakers who are not yet members of PSA. The goal is to nurture a cohort of speakers who are well regarded and successful in their speaking practice. We hope to further establish the PSA brand in the community and develop a pipeline of future members and leaders.


